#### Luke 2:41-52

### The Boy Jesus Amazes the Scholars

- <sup>41</sup> His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover.
- <sup>42</sup> And when He was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast.
- <sup>43</sup> When they had finished the days, as they returned, the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother\* did not know *it*;
- <sup>44</sup> but supposing Him to have been in the company, they went a day's journey, and sought Him among *their* relatives and acquaintances.
- <sup>45</sup> So when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him.
- <sup>46</sup> Now so it was *that* after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.
- <sup>47</sup> And all who heard Him were astonished at His understanding and answers.
- <sup>48</sup> So when they saw Him, they were amazed; and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously."
- <sup>49</sup> And He said to them, "Why did you seek Me? Did you not know that I must be about My Father's business?"
  - <sup>50</sup> But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them.

### Jesus Advances in Wisdom and Favor

- <sup>51</sup> Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart.
- <sup>52</sup> And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

### Visit to Jerusalem

- <sup>41</sup> Now His parents went to Jerusalem every year at <sup>a</sup>the Feast of the Passover.

- <sup>43</sup> and as they were returning, after spending the <sup>a</sup>full number of days, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. But His parents were unaware of it.
- <sup>44</sup> but supposed Him to be in the caravan, and went a day's journey; and they *began* looking for Him among their relatives and acquaintances.
- <sup>45</sup> When they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem looking for Him.
- <sup>46</sup> Then, after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.
- <sup>47</sup> And all who heard Him <sup>a</sup>were amazed at His understanding and His answers.
- <sup>48</sup> When they saw Him, they were astonished; and <sup>a</sup>His mother said to Him, "<sup>1</sup>Son, why have You treated us this way? Behold, <sup>b</sup>Your father and I <sup>2</sup>have been anxiously looking for You."
- <sup>49</sup> And He said to them, "Why is it that you were looking for Me? Did you not know that all had to be in My Father's *house?*"
- <sup>50</sup> But athey did not understand the statement which He 1had made to them.
- <sup>51</sup> And He went down with them and came to <sup>a</sup>Nazareth, and He continued in subjection to them; and <sup>b</sup>His mother <sup>c</sup>treasured all *these* <sup>1</sup>things in her heart.
- <sup>52</sup> And Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and ¹stature, and in afavor with God and men.
