

## 11-6-16 Scripture Reading

### Rom 12:4-8 (NASB)

<sup>4</sup> For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function,

<sup>5</sup> so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

<sup>6</sup> And since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, *let each exercise them accordingly*: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith;

<sup>7</sup> if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching;

<sup>8</sup> or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

### 1 Cor 12:12-13, 18 (NASB)

<sup>12</sup> For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.

<sup>13</sup> For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

<sup>18</sup> But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired.

### Rom 12:4-8 (NIV)

<sup>4</sup> Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function,

<sup>5</sup> so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

<sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his<sup>b</sup> faith.

<sup>7</sup> If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach;

<sup>8</sup> if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

### 1 Cor 12:13-14, 18 (NIV)

<sup>13</sup> For we were all baptized by<sup>c</sup> one Spirit into one body — whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free — and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

<sup>14</sup> Now the body is not made up of one part but of many.

<sup>18</sup> But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be.
