# **Introduction:**

- •History behind the English word "church" in the Bible
  - 1. Once absent from all English translations the word of choice was "c\_\_\_\_\_" or "assembly"
  - 2. First appears in the King James Version (1611)
    - a. This translation was c\_\_\_\_\_ by King James
    - b. The English word referred to a b\_\_\_\_\_
- •Biblically, the Greek word translated as church is used 114 times
  - 1. Every time it refers to p\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. The word literally means "c\_\_\_\_\_ out ones"
- •God speaks through the church. How?

## You have an individual and a corporate identity – member

- •Two key words used in both Rom 12:4,5 and 1Cor 12:12,18,27
  - 1. M\_\_\_\_\_
  - 2. B\_\_\_\_\_
- •Your individual identity
  - 1. When first saved you became a c\_\_\_\_\_ of God (John 1:12)
  - You can personally come before God without anyone else's h\_\_\_\_\_\_(1Tim 2:5; Heb 4:12).
  - 3. Although there are 7 billion people in the world, God is p\_\_\_\_\_ with each believer (Rev 2:17).
  - 4. This, however, is not sufficient
- •Your corporate identity
  - Both passages emphasize the importance of being c\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the body

     We are automatically connected to the universal body of Christ upon receiving
     Christ as our Lord and Savior. This is done by the S\_\_\_\_\_\_ (1Cor 12:13).
    - b. We each have to connect ourselves to a l\_\_\_\_\_ body of believers.
  - 2. If we are not connected corporately to a local body, how can we hear what God is saying through the church?

## You have an individual and corporate duty – mutual encouragement

- •Both passages emphasize each member f\_\_\_\_\_ in the body.
  - 1. We do NOT decide what p\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the body we are but must allow God to tell us where He has placed us (1Cor 12:18).
  - 2. We DO decide to f\_\_\_\_\_\_ in the body (Rom 12:6; Rom 1:11,12)
- •We live in a selfish society "What's in it for me?"
  - P\_\_\_\_\_
  - M\_\_\_\_\_
  - C\_\_\_\_\_

- •We were saved from self and so should be selfless (Lk 9:23)
  - 1. JFK "Ask not what your country can do for you but what you can do for your country."
  - 2. Ask not what is your spouse doing for you, but what are you doing for your spouse?
  - 3. Ask not what is the church doing for me, but what am I doing for the church?
    - a. The local church is C\_\_\_\_\_ body. (1Cor 12:27) and therefore LBC is not my church but His. The church does not belong to me but I belong to the church.
    - b. The head of the local church is C\_\_\_\_\_(Col 1:18).

## **Together we function as Christ's body – He directs (Col 1:18)**

•How does this work out, practically speaking?

- 1. We engage in mutual e\_\_\_\_\_\_ (serving, teaching, leading, mercy, giving, helping, counseling, encouraging, etc)
- 2. The results will be spiritual g\_\_\_\_\_ and/or spiritual life
- 3. God will speak to individuals through the church body and will speak to the body giving us direction.

#### •Examples

- 1. How have you received encouragement in the church?
- 2. How have you given encouragement in the church?
- 3. How has God spoken to you through this church?
- 4. How has God spoken to this church body?
