1) John 8:23-25 – Unless you believe that I AM, you will die
in your sins. (Most versions insert e words
after "I am" that are not in the original text). The Jews
understood Jesus to mean, "Unless you believe who I am"
as seen in verse 25. They misunderstood. (Believing Jesus
to be Yahweh is necessary to s
2) John 8:28 – When you lift up the Son of Man, you will
know that I AM. (again they misunderstood Jesus)
3) John 8:58 – Before Abraham was, I AM. There was only
one way to understand this!

The Apostles Presented Jesus Christ as Yahweh
●John 1:1,14 – the Word existed as G and became flesh
•Romans 10:9-13 – this passage explains what it means to confess Jesus
as L
1. Vv. 11,13 – confess means to b (i.e. trust) in Him as
Lord and to c on Him as Lord
2. V. 13 identifies the Lord as Y (it is a quote
from Joel 2:32 – note that in the O.T., "LORD" (all capital letters)
translates the Hebrew name Yahweh.
●Hebrews 1:10
1. The context is what Yahweh says about the Son (v. 8) – He says
this (quotes an O.T. passage) and this (quotes another passage)
2. In verse 8, He calls the Son, G
3. In verse 10, He calls the Son, L (check Ps 102:25, it
is in all capital letters and so means Yahweh)
