Phil 2:12-13 (NASU)

<sup>12</sup> So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling;

<sup>13</sup> for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for *His* good pleasure.

## Phil 2:12-13 (NIV)

<sup>12</sup> Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed — not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence — continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,

<sup>13</sup> for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.

## Phil 2:12-13 (NLT)

<sup>12</sup> Dear friends, you always followed my instructions when I was with you. And now that I am away, it is even more important. Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep reverence and fear.

<sup>13</sup> For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him.

<sup>8</sup> For <sup>a</sup>by grace you have been saved <sup>b</sup>through faith; and <sup>1</sup>that not of yourselves, *it is* <sup>c</sup>the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> <sup>a</sup>not as a result of works, so that <sup>b</sup>no one may boast. <sup>1</sup>
