- 2. Satan is tempting Jesus to use His p______ to satisfy His own hunger. It can be translated as: *Since You are the Son of God.*
 - a. The Jewish people of Jesus' day believed that the Christ would repeat the miracle of m_____ (John 6:30,31)
 - b. Satan was ultimately trying to tempt Jesus to be the kind of Christ that the Jews were expecting and so avoid suffering.
